

PINE ECHO CAMP RULES

Please read carefully!

- Pets are not allowed on the beaches, or anywhere in the lake, they must be tied up, or on a leash at all times. You must clean up after your pet.
- It is illegal to walk around the campground with exposed alcoholic beverages. There is no alcohol allowed on the beaches or at the diving area.
- Nightly quiet hours are from **11:30 PM till 8:00 AM.**
- Enforced speed limit throughout the campground is **15 km/h.**
- Do not cut across or park on other peoples' campsites
- Excessive noise, drunkenness, profanity or violence will not be tolerated.
- Campsites are to be maintained in a neat and orderly manner. Your grass must be kept cut.
- Decks, sheds, and additions must be approved by management before being constructed, and all additions must have siding on them.
- No cutting of trees or shrubs without management approval.
- Keep our camp litter free by using the garbage containers.
- Only dining room tents without floors are permitted. No tents allowed on your lot unless approved by management.
- Drinking and driving will not be tolerated in this campground.
- Campers are liable for any damage done to camp property caused by themselves, family members, or their guests.
- All guests must be registered at the office. Seasonal campers are responsible for the conduct of their guests, and they are requested to leave by 11:30 PM, unless they are paid overnight guests.
- When you leave the campground with your trailer, your lot is expected to be in the same condition as it was when you rented it. Anything in the ground must remain here.
- Parents are asked to be in control of their children at all times. Never leave them in the camp unattended. All persons 16 years old and under are subject to an 11:30 PM curfew, and must be at an adult supervised campsite at that time.
- Management must be notified of any selling of trailers in the camp. New owners and trailers must be approved as well.
- Recreational vehicles left in the park are at the owner's risk, so we urge you to have your insurance kept up for the full year.
- Use of off road vehicles, or motorcycles in the camp are strictly prohibited.
- Firearms and fireworks are strictly prohibited.
- Locks must be placed on all outside refrigerators, or the refrigerator must be placed inside a locked shed.
- Each campsite is allowed one trailer only and no more than two vehicles parked on their lot.
- Security gate cards are not to be loaned out or used by anyone other than the seasonal camper it was registered to.
- No visitors are allowed in the camp off-season.
